2.	<p>Lunchtime</p> <p>Lots of changes have been made at lunchtime – trays in the dining hall, zones in the playground and use of the Orchard for calming time. We discussed what is going well:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Like the trays as no pushing. People are getting kinder. The trim trail is the favourite - Like the dancing, with a good choice of music. Like sitting where they want in the hall as can sit with friends. The running track is the favourite - Likes the stilts. The trim trail is their favourite - Fewer people falling out. Behaviour is better in the hall. Favourite is the trim trail - Like the dancing area which is the favourite - Likes the trays in the hall and the dancing area outside is the favourite <p>We then talked about any issues or suggested changes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The gate near BOB has been closed – should be open? - Could children be allowed to chose what goes on their tray eg could chose not to have coleslaw if they didn't want it, but could this happen more frequently? - Some people are running in the walking area - the areas for running and walking are not equal - some children move equipment from zone to zone
3.	<p>Thrive</p> <p>This term Orion is the lead looking at fundraising as Chancellor which ties in with Thrive. Together the children had lots of ideas of what could be on the night, and how we could prepare for it.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Rainbow themed - Wristbands to be sold by childrens gov - Colour bead trail - Collect donations and sell baby toys - Calm corner - Dancing area - Orion to write a letter to send out requesting donations for a raffle - Imagine Avenue in the Orchard
